



YELLOW PEACHES: SEMI-CLING VARIETIES

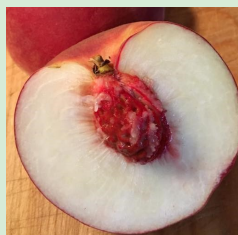


Semi-cling peaches are those that do not release easily from the pit, hence the “cling” descriptor. The more “clingy” peaches always ripen before the freestone varieties. In our area and at our orchard, these ripen from mid-June through about July 10.

WHITE PEACHES: SEMI-CLING & FREESTONE VARIETIES



White Peaches have white flesh that contains less acid (not as tangy) than standard yellow peaches, making them taste sweeter. We have semi-cling and freestone varieties.
